

Proposed Motion for Provisional/Full FISAC Membership

Be it moved that the following policy be accepted as FISAC operating policy.

Multiple “National” Organizations With Multiple Clubs As Members In One Country

FISAC encourages, with the support of the continental organization of the country in question, any country with multiple “national” rope skipping organizations to collaborate to become a single unified National Rope Skipping Organization.

In the interim, any nation with multiple provisional FISAC membership which is wishing to submit a national delegation to compete at the FISAC World Rope Skipping Championships, where there are two or more “national” rope skipping organizations, must:

- 1) Submit by Sept 30 the intention to attend the FISAC World Rope Skipping Championships in the following calendar year.

If there is more than one intention-to-attend received by FISAC from any nation, the nation’s “national” organizations must:

- a. Hold an open qualifying competition at a suitable time for all the interested “national” organizations, which occurs prior to the FISAC World Rope Skipping Championship’s registration deadline.
- b. Where all of the country’s athletes can compete to be part of the national delegation.
- c. At the expense of the competition, the organizers must host one FISAC Board Member or FISAC approved designate, including the coverage of travel and accommodation, to attend and oversee the competition to ensure its fairness.

If these conditions cannot be met, then no athletes from the country in question may attend the FISAC World Rope Skipping Championships for the given year.
